

Let's Walk Bishopston

St Andrews Park to Ashley Down Green

A gentle, level linear walk on pavements linking a large well-established park in Bishopston (which has views to the west) to a new public open space in Ashley Down with good views east to Purdown.

Distance: 0.6 miles / 0.9 km

Allow: About 15 minutes

Suitability: Easy access for walkers and wheelchairs.

1. START: The gate at the top corner of St Andrews Park by the junction of Maurice Road and Sommerville Roads. Cross Sommerville Road at the zebra crossing, turn left and then immediately right into Derby Road. Walk along the right hand pavement, following the road as it bends left and crossing the mouth of Happy Lane.

2. Cross Sefton Park Road at the raised table, and turn right to walk along the left hand side of Sefton Park Road. Cross Stanley Avenue and continue along Sefton Park Road to the end.

3. At the end of Sefton Park Road, turn left into Ashley Down Road. Cross the small road that leads into the College and, immediately after, cross Ashley Down Road at the pelican crossing. Turn left and continue to the first turning on the right, Dirac Road.

4. Turn right into Dirac Road; at the T junction, follow the bend around to the right. As you walk along, Ashley Down Green opens up to the right.
